

PROFESSIONAL PREDICTIONS



- ◎ Professional judgment of the teacher
- ◎ Likely grade at the end of the GCSE course
- ◎ GCSE grades are now 9 - 1 for all subjects apart from DT
- ◎ Each grade will have sublevels 1, 2 and 3. Fine Grades are: 51, 52, 53 etc

DfE regards Grade 4 as a “standard” pass at GCSE

and

a Grade 5 as a “strong” pass at GCSE



PROFESSIONAL PREDICTIONS - REFORMED GCSEs EXCEPT SCIENCE

Explanation of grades:

- ◎51 - secure Grade 5 but with intervention could **boost** to a grade 6
- ◎52 - insecure Grade 5, intervention necessary to **secure or boost** a grade 5
- ◎53 - very insecure Grade 5, intervention certainly necessary to **secure** a grade 5
- ◎The same definitions apply to all other Grades too, from 9 to 1.

PROFESSIONAL PREDICTIONS - REFORMED SCIENCE GCSEs



- ◎ Science is a double GCSE and as such your daughter has two grades e.g. 55 means two grade 5s
- ◎ Her professional Prediction:
 - ◎ 551 - two secure Grade 5s but with intervention could boost to grade 6s,
 - ◎ 552 - insecure Grade 5s, intervention necessary to secure or boost grade 5s
 - ◎ 553 - very insecure Grade 5s, intervention certainly necessary to secure grade 5s

The same definitions apply to all other Grades too, from 9 to 1.
