Yr 12 Transition Work

1. You are going to do some research on 'education'.

Decide what your aim is e.g. to *find out what pupils' experience of school has been*, or to *investigate gender differences between boys and girls*, or *attitudes to learning*, or *the way teachers behave in the classroom* or *outcomes at school comparing different ethnic groups*.

2. Decide how you are going to research this: choose either a questionnaire or an interview.

Explain why you have chosen this method.

3. Make your questionnaire or interview questions.

4. Give your questionnaire to 10 people or carry out your interview with 3 people (make sure you ask the people for permission, tell them their names will not be used and write down the answers you get in the interview).

5. Summarise your results - what you have found out?

6. What problems did you encounter in your research study?

7. Attach one example of a completed questionnaire or interview with the answers above.
