Re: October Half term 25th October – 29th October 2021

I would like to take this opportunity to remind families that school will close for the half term on **Friday 22nd October at 3:25pm**. School will re-open on **Monday 1st November** for all year groups at the usual time.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind parents and carers of some important procedures.

Attendance

It is vital for your daughter to attend school regularly to minimise as far as possible the longer-term impact of the pandemic on their education, wellbeing and wider development. We know that children are enjoying being with their friends and the wider social aspects of school. We are keen to make sure students are moving forward in terms of their learning and this is so much easier to secure when students are present.

If you are worried about your daughter attending school, for any reason, the first port of call is to discuss your concerns with the school directly. In addition, this is not the time to take your daughter out of school for a family holiday or other term time leave.

Punctuality

In addition to ensuring excellent attendance, we would also like to remind everybody about the importance of punctuality. Arriving late for school will mean a disrupted start to the day, will disrupt the learning of others and students will miss out on key information.

Face coverings

We have a number of students and their families who are at serious risk should they contract the virus. We ask that all students, unless exempt, wear a face covering in the corridors and when requested to do so.

Uniform, jewellery and mobile phones

Please ensure that all students are in full uniform, including black school shoes. Students should not wear jewellery. Mobile phones must be turned off and out of sight in a bag or inside blazer pockets. If they are seen in school, they will be confiscated and parents/carers may have to come and collect them.
