Re: Wearing Face Masks in School

I hope you and your family are well and have had a safe start to the new academic year.

We have built in formal reviews of our Risk Assessment, however, we also reflect back on each day and pose ourselves the question "is there anything else we can do to ensure our learning family is as safe as possible?" With that in mind we have made the decision that from Monday 14th September 2020, our community (staff and students) will wear face masks in corridors and communal areas within school, unless there is a medical reason which means you are exempt. Students will not be required to wear them in classrooms. Masks can be removed when eating lunch and once consumed should be worn. Please ensure your daughter has a plain washable or disposable face mask from Monday.

Please be aware that masks with logos, scarves, bandanas or snoods are not allowed.

I have no doubt our community will embrace this request and as you would expect any misuse of face masks and placing others at risk will be taken seriously.

We are in an ever changing environment and as our Learning Family comes back in increasing numbers we will continue to review our protocols to prioritise everyone's safety.
